Billions are invested in Indian cities and towns to ensure that urban infrastructure keeps pace with rapid expansion and population growth. The success of these investments depends on the capacity of urban policymakers and operational leaders to make the right choices and implement sustainable solutions. Yet most cities find that they lack the necessary individual and institutional capacity to respond to urban challenges.

At WRI India, we bridge this gap by rendering the knowledge we have gained from cities into training programs and learning resources that we can share with them. We draw from our extensive research and study of urban and mobility planning in cities worldwide to create tools, accessible guidance and training materials. These are disseminated through various capacity building channels to help stakeholders identify and implement sustainable solutions in their cities.

We offer customized learning programs for different audiences: be it delivering a workshop for urban planners on how to secure financing for Transit Oriented Development projects; facilitating a webinar series for city authorities on designing, implementing and financing Public Bike Share systems; running a Mobility Lab to validate business models for entrepreneurs; or facilitating driver training for improved fuel efficiency for state-run bus companies.
